- ◆ Council approval is required to use the Memorial Gardens for Wedding Ceremonies/Photographs. The completion of an application form and approval from Council will avoid double bookings.
- ◆ No cars are to be driven into the Memorial Gardens.
- ◆ No umbrellas or marquees may be erected within the gardens.
- ◆ Confetti and rice are NOT allowed, but flower petals may be used.
- ◆ The gardens must be left in the condition they were found. Please notify Council of any problems or concerns.
- ◆ Parties or Wedding Receptions are NOT to be held in the Memorial Gardens.
- ◆ The consumption of alcohol within the gardens is not permitted.
- ◆ Groups that use the Memorial Gardens for weddings and/or photographs do so on the clear understanding that they do not have a right to exclude other persons from any part of the park.

Council will endeavour to fulfil any reasonable requests of groups wanting to make use of the Memorial Gardens for Ceremonies and/or Photographs. There may be circumstances where requests may not be met.

Persons organising and participating in private functions at the Memorial Gardens do so at their own risk. The Council accepts no liability for loss, damage and injury whatsoever which may be brought or made or claimed against it or any of its servants or agents arising out of or in relation to the participation of private functions at the Memorial Gardens.
