### FOOD SCRAPS GO IN THE GREEN BIN

Council provides a free kitchen caddy and year supply of compostable bags to make it easy.

These are available from the Town of Walkerville Civic & Community Centre, 66 Walkerville Terrace, Gilberton.

Food scraps placed in your green bin takes the pressure off rates and gets turned into mulch and compost products.

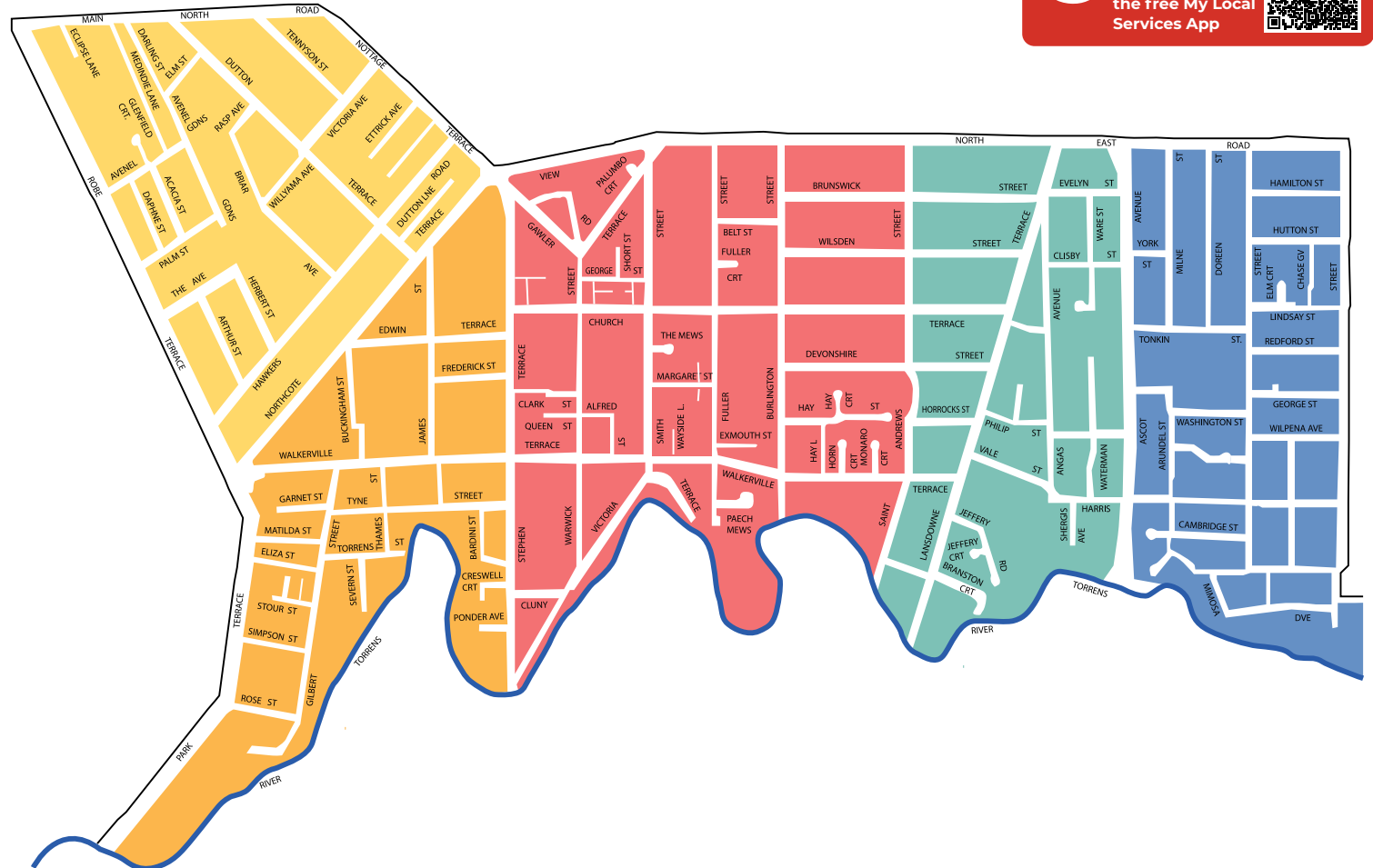

- No collections on New Year's Day, Good Friday or Christmas Day. All collections will move to the next day for the remaining week.

### KERBSIDE BIN PLACEMENT

Where practical, keep a minimum distance of 50cm between bins, and 1 metre between bins and parked cars, street trees, stobie poles and letterboxes. Please remove bins after they have been emptied on the day of collection.
