# Footpath renewal and kerb repair

Starting Monday, 13 November 2023, the Town of Walkerville will be undertaking its annual footpath renewal program, as well as various kerb and gutter repair work.

The paths in this year's 2023/24 Footpath Renewal Program are:

- Nottage Terrace, Medindie – Northcote Terrace to Main North Road.
- Smith Street, Walkerville – Church Terrace to Walkerville Oval car park entrance.
- North East Road, Walkerville (various patch repair) – Smith Street to Stephen Terrace.

The footpaths will be constructed in asphalt to match in with the existing material.

The kerb and gutter repairs have been scheduled for the following roads:

- Victoria Terrace, Walkerville;
- Church Terrace, Walkerville;
- Ponder Avenue, Gilberton;
- Redford Street, Vale Park;
- Wilpena Avenue, Vale Park;
- Tonkin Street, Vale Park; and
- Tennyson Street, Medindie.

Works will occur over the next two months leading up to Christmas. The contractors will letter drop residents to forewarn them of upcoming works. During this time, it would be appreciated if residents do not park their car on the road.

## Minor landscaping works at Belt Reserve

The Town of Walkerville will soon be undertaking minor landscaping works in Belt Reserve, located on the corner of Church Terrace and Fuller Street in Walkerville.

Works will include the installation of a small shelter, new bench seat, brick feature pillars, exposed aggregate concrete pad, new paving and plantings.



The highlight of the works will be the feature paving, which will include banding across the existing footpath as well as a paved 'cross' and plaque in recognition of the St. Andrew's Anglican Church's 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. Works are expected to be completed by the end of the year.





## Mulch works at local playgrounds

Over the next four to six weeks, all local playgrounds will be receiving new mulch.



Residents can expect some playgrounds to be unavailable during the installation of the new mulch for a short period of time.

Hamilton Reserve recently had new soft fall mulch blown in and the works are now completed.

Alfred Street Playground and Levi Oval Playground will be next to receive new soft fall mulch.

It is expected that these public spaces will be temporarily closed for a morning to undertake the work.

Designed to help small businesses access one-on-one advice from experienced Business Advisors across all aspects of business development, the Eastern Region Alliance (ERA) Small Business Advisory Service is being launched to respond to current issues faced by business owners.

The Service will help guide businesses in making the best decisions for their business and will be available to eligible small businesses (0 to 19 employees) operating within the ERA councils, which includes Town of Walkerville.

The service is seeking expressions of interest for qualified Business Advisors to support the delivery of the Service. From marketing and social media to financial advice and tourism – if your business offers a service or speciality that would benefit the local region, and you would like to mentor nearby small businesses who need assistance in this area, please apply to be considered for the ERA Small Business Advisory Service.

Selected Business Advisors will be engaged by ERA councils to provide their services on an as-needs / pay-for-service basis at a fee of \$150, plus GST, per one-hour session.

Eligible businesses will be able to access up to three free one-hour sessions per financial year.

The first set of new Asset Management Plans will be closed to community consultation from 5pm today.

In accordance with the *Local Government Act 1999*, Council is required to review its Asset Management Plans a minimum of every four years to ensure the Township's valuable services – including roads, footpaths, kerbs, carparks, buildings, stormwater, open spaces, plants and equipment – are properly maintained to a high standard. This allows Council to deliver the required level of service to the community in the most cost-effective manner.

To ensure there is appropriate oversight of these assets, Council reviews sections of the Asset Management Plans to ensure these important assets are well-maintained and meeting community expectations.

This year's draft Asset Management Plans for review cover the roads, footpaths and stormwater systems of the Town of Walkerville.

The draft Asset Management Plans closes to public consultation at 5pm on Friday, 10 November 2023.
